The Greensboro Symphony Youth Orchestra season calendar traditionally has three concert cycles with approximately eight rehearsals each. Auditions for new members are held in the Fall, and occasionally in the Spring for the following season.

Standard audition and rehearsal location is the UNCG School of Music.

Standard rehearsal times are:

Youth Orchestra - 2:00-5:00 p.m. (room 111)

Youth Philharmonic - 3:30-5:00 p.m. (room 110)

Youth Camerata - 2:00-3:20 p.m. (room 110)

The standard GSYO concert start time is 4:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoons.

Concert dates include dress rehearsals prior to the performances. Detailed information will be announced in the month prior to each concert.

Music will be distributed at the first rehearsal of each concert cycle.

Practice hearings may take place before/after ensemble rehearsal on or after the third week of each cycle. Practice hearings will be announced at least two weeks prior.

Greensboro Symphony staff may observe instrument sections and/or full ensembles, within the normal rehearsal setting, midway through each concert cycle.

The GSYO Retreat is a two-day event. Youth Philharmonic attends on the first day from 2:00-8:00 p.m.. Dinner is provided. Year-specific information will be announced by the first rehearsal of the season.
