Directions:

- In Northern Guilford County, take NC 150 to Spearman Rd. (heading North)
- Spearman Rd. continues to the Park; turn left on to Conference Center Dr.
- Once in the Park, follow the road all the way to the “round house” (Osprey Nest / Fox Den) to sign in.

What to bring (all ensembles):

1. Instrument/case, labeled with your name
2. All sheet music and a pencil
3. Water bottle

For Youth Orchestra:

4. Sleeping bag (or bed sheets and a blanket) and a pillow
5. Towel, washcloth, and other personal overnight items
6. Casual clothes and comfortable shoes
7. Flashlight
8. Recreational items (soccer ball, frisbee)
9. Raincoat, umbrella, or jacket
10. (optional) Folk instrument to play for campfire jam session

Policies

Participation in retreat is required. As a reminder, students are expected to behave in a respectful and courteous manner at all times, and to abide by all policies in the GSYO handbook. Additionally, students must respect all in-cabin curfew times, only go into cabins to which they are assigned, and stay in designated areas of the park. No siblings or guests are allowed at GSYO retreat. If violations occur, the student's parents/guardians will be responsible for transporting the student home.

Students must sign in upon arrival and sign out at departure.
