**Youth Philharmonic: Saturday ONLY**

Arrive 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 10; Depart 8:00 p.m. (No rehearsal on Sunday, October 11.)

**Youth Camerata: Sunday ONLY**

Arrive at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, Oct. 11, Depart 4:30 p.m.

**Junior Philharmonic: Sunday ONLY**

Arrive at 12:30 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 11, Depart 4:00 p.m.

Check in & out is at the **Herman Hall** building.

**Directions:**

- From the “new” I-85 highway, take the exit for Youngs Mill Rd. headed South/East.  
*(not the older Business 85 / I-40 that runs through central Greensboro)*
- At the end of Youngs Mill Rd., make a left on to Millpoint Rd.; Stay on Millpoint as it curves.  
*(do not turn on to Thacker Dairy Rd.)*
- In about a mile and a half, there is a sign on the right for Camp Weaver (Tapawingo Trail)

**What to bring**

1. Your instrument/case, labeled with your name
2. A folding music stand, also labeled with your name
3. All sheet music and a pencil
4. A water bottle

**For Youth Orchestra and Repertory Strings (Overnight):**

5. Sleeping bag (or bed sheets and a blanket) and a pillow
6. Towel, washcloth, and other personal overnight items
7. Casual clothes and comfortable shoes
8. Flashlight
9. Recreational items (soccer ball, frisbee)
10. Raincoat, umbrella, or jacket
11. (optional) A folk instrument that you would like to play for a campfire jam session

**What NOT to bring**

1. Any valuable possessions (other than your instrument)
2. Electronic equipment
3. Skateboards, scooters, or bicycles

**Policies**

Participation in retreat is mandatory. As a reminder, students are expected to behave in a respectful and courteous manner at all times, and to abide by all policies in the GSYO handbook. Additionally, students must respect all in-cabin curfew times, only go into cabins to which they are assigned, and stay in designated areas of the camp. No siblings or guests are allowed at GSYO retreat. If violations occur, the student’s parents/guardians will be responsible for transporting the student home.

Students must sign in upon arrival and sign out at departure. Parents - please pick up your child/children promptly at the scheduled departure times.
